BURGLARY DWELLING X 4

Ripponden Road, Denshaw on 24th August at 15:00hrs unknown offenders smash the conservatory door and gain access to the property. Offenders conduct an untidy search stealing the victims' car keys before making off in a red Ford Fiesta. (Victims car was not stolen.)

Denshaw Road, Delph between 11th August at 23:00hrs and 12th August 00:00hrs unknown offenders gain entry to a property via an insecure rear door. Once inside the offenders conduct a search stealing items. Offenders then use the front door keys to open the front door and make off in unknown direction.

Denshaw Vale, Denshaw between 8th August at 22:00hrs and 9th August at 10:00hrs, unknown offenders approach the front door to the premises and using an unknown implement attempt to force the same. No entry is gained *and* offenders make off from scene.

Green Lane, Moorside on 5th August at 08:59 hrs unknown offenders in a white van reverse their vehicle up to a container which is on the victims land. Drilling and can be heard and the lock is prized open. The offenders steal a quad bike from inside the container and make off

BURGLARY OTHER THAN A DWELLING X 1

Huddersfield Road, Diggle on the 10th August between 14:00hrs and 18:05hrs, unknown offender enters a property via the staff entrance and goes to the office area. Offender then steals the victims handbag before making off in an unknown direction.

THEFT FROM A VEHICLE x 6

Hill View, Delph between the 26th August at 23:00hrs and 27th August at 07:30hrs. Offender enters the side door of a parked secure vehicle and removes property from within.

Hill View, Delph between the 26th August at 23:00hrs and 27th August at 07:30hrs unknown offender gains access to vehicle by unknown means and steals items from inside before making off in unknown direction.

Sandy Lane, Dobcross between 25th August 23:00hrs and 26th August 09:00hrs. Offender enters vehicle by unknown means and steals golf clubs .

Huddersfield Road, Waterhead, between 18th August 17:00hrs and 19th August 07:45hrs Unknown offenders steal a catalytic converter from a parked secure vehicle.

Hillend Road, Delph on 17th August at 16:00hrs unknown offenders smash rear window of a van before removing power tools and stealing the same.

Stoneswood Road, Delph, between 17:15hrs and 18:00hrs on 10th August Offenders smash the front offside window of a vehicle before reaching in and stealing items of property from inside.

THEFT OF A VEHICLE x 1

Oldham Road, Delph between the 8th August 20:00hrs and 9th August 07:00hrs unknown offenders enter the yard of the farm and steal a motor vehicle with a defective drive shaft which was not driveable. The offenders then either tow or load the vehicle onto an unknown vehicle in order to steal it and make off from the scene.

CRIMINAL DAMAGE X 25

Wall Hill Road, Dobcross on 31st August at 21:00hrs damage to vehicles by youths throwing eggs. (The offenders have been identified and are being dealt with via Restorative Justice.)

Ladcastle Road, Dobcross on the 31st August 21:20hrs damage to vehicle (offenders as above and being dealt with via Restorative Justice)

Huddersfield Road, Waterhead 31st August at 17:00hrs. Damage to property.

Lodge Lane, Delph 25th August at 21:00hrs damage to property by known offender.

Huddersfield Road, Scouthead x 19, on the 6th August. Known offender has been arrested and charged with using a traffic cone to cause damage to 19 motor vehicles.

Thurston Clough Road, Dobcross, between 5th August 16:00hrs and 6th August 11:42hrs unknown offenders use scaffolding to climb onto the roof of a property and steal slate.

Dobcross New Road, Dobcross, 2nd August damage to motor vehicle

ROBBERY X 1

Huddersfield Road, Scouthead 6th August 01:00 .

The Victim witnesses a male causing damage to motor vehicles so follows him in his personal vehicle to try and observe whilst police are on route. The victim loses sight of the male so parks up and exits the vehicle in order to speak with another member of the public. The offender reappears and approaches the victim carrying a large rock. The victim runs back to his vehicle and attempts to start the engine. The offender follows him so the victim in fear for his personal safety exits the vehicle and runs away. The offender then steals his vehicle and drives off. (Male offender arrested and charged for this offence)
