The Square, High St, Uppermill. 21/12/18 23:30hrs.

Two men have been charged with murder following the death of a man in Uppermill.

Daniel Forster (05/07/1994), of Ashfield Crescent, Springhead and Michael Milligan Nield (27/01/1994), of Society Street, Shaw have both been charged with the murder of 34-year-old Daniel Hogan.

The charges are in relation to an incident which took place on High Street on Friday 21 December 2018. Police were called shortly after 11:30pm on Friday 21 December 2018 to reports that a man had collapsed with head injuries.

Emergency services attended and administered first aid to the man before he was rushed to hospital, where he sadly died a short time later.

He has since been formally identified as Daniel Hogan. Daniel was originally from Rochdale but had recently been living in Saddleworth.

GMP would like to thank the local community for the significant amount of support offered since the incident took place. The investigation continues and anyone with information should contact police on 0161 856 9283 or the independent charity Crimestoppers, anonymously, on 0800 555 111.

What to do if you are a victim of a crime

- Report the incident to the police
- Try to recall as much as possible about the event and details of the people involved; take the name and address of any witnesses
- If a car was involved, try to note its details such as colour, make, and registration number
- List any missing items
- Contact your insurance company
- Change your locks if your keys have been taken; check if your insurance will cover this cost
- If your cards have been stolen, call your bank or credit Card Company as soon as possible, the number will be on your statement.
