Crime figures for 1st – 28th February 2019

Burglary Residential = 3 (Homes, sheds, garages)

Knowl Farm, Standedge, Delph – 11 Feb – 2:45pm; 2X Unknown Males Have Gain Entry to Aps Garage by Damaging The door. They Make an Untidy search Of Premises and Of A Vehicle Inside, Stealing Items From Within. The Occupant Disturbs Offenders And Sees 1X Of Them make Off To A White Van Waiting Nearby Where The Other Offender Is and Both Make Off In the Vehicle.

Sam Road, Diggle: - 15 Feb 6:45pm - Offenders Go Up a Track At Side Property. Access the Rear Yard Via Insecure Gate. Using Slim Edged Implement Force Ground Floor Window. Offender Reaches Inside property Triggering House Alarm. Is seen to make Off On Silver Scooter Down Sam Road Towards Huddersfield Road and out of sight.

Clydesdale Rise, Diggle: -21-22 Feb 3-8 pm; - Offender Has Approached House From The Back, Smashed The Patio Door Glass. Entered The Property And Conduct An Untidy Search stealing Items From within The Property. Including the occupants vehicle Keys. Offender Has Left The Property And Located Vehicle. Using The Keys Taken to Steal it – (YD60PKA, Mazda, 2, Red)

Burglary Community = 2 (Businesses and non-residential)

Bent Heath Farm, Ripponden Road, Denshaw: - 11 Feb 1pm: - Two Offenders Attended The Area In Separate Motor Vehicles - One Alighted His Vehicle And Joined The Other Before Driving Down To The Farm And entering An Insecure Barn - The Offenders Removed Horse Tack (Saddles And blankets) Then Exited With Same And Made Off - Direction Unknown

Wool Road Farm, Wool Road, Diggle: - 15 Feb 9 – 10pm - Offender Has Approached Farm From A Unknown Direction. Used A Unknown Implement And Smashed Through The external Electric Box To turn The Key To electric Gate and Access The Yard Of The Farm. They Have Entered The Yard and Conducted An Untidy Search Stolen Items From The Site And left The Scene in unknown direction

Theft from Motor Vehicle = 3

Wool Road, Dobcross; - 9 Feb 3:30 – 5 pm - Offenders Smash The Rear Nearside Window Reach into Vehicle And Steal A Bag Containing Items Then Make Off In Unknown direction

Doctor House Fold, Doctor Lane, Scouthead: - 16 Feb 10:00-10:30 am - Offender; Takes Items from Within Insecure Vehicle And Makes Off Unseen And In Unknown direction

Belmont Avenue, Springhead: - 22-23 Feb 11-30pm – 8 am - Offender(s) Approach Parked Secured Motor vehicle From Unknown Direction; Use Unknown Implement To Prise Side Sliding door Open; Enter Vehicle; Steal Tools From Within and Make Off Unseen In Unknown Direction.

Lee Cross Cottage, Lee Cross, Diggle: - 22 Feb 7:30- 9pm - Offender Approaches Locked And Secure Vehicle Takes Same by Unknown Means And Makes Off Making Good Their Escape Unseen and In Unknown Direction

New Barn, Denshaw Road, Delph,: 7 Feb 2pm ; - Offenders Were In Process Of Stealing Antique Agricultural Plough so p ABlocked Private Drive Way With His Vehicle. Offenders In Attempt To Escape Area Drive Up Lane Causing Ap To Drive Into Ditch Causing Damage To wheel . Offenders Vehicle Collided With F/n/s Wing Causing Minor Scrapes. Offenders Made Off On To Denshaw Road In Direction Of Denshaw

Shiloh Lane, Strinesdale: 8-9 Feb 6pm – 7am: - Offender(s) Have Smashed Rear screen of vehicle (No Entry Gained Into Vehicle)

Bakestones Ave, Delph: - 15 Feb 01:30am: - Offender(s) Have Smashed all windows of vehicle (No Entry Gained Into Vehicle)

What to do if you are a victim of a crime

- Report the incident to the police
- Try to recall as much as possible about the event and details of the people involved; take the name and address of any witnesses
- If a car was involved, try to note its details such as colour, make, and registration number
- List any missing items
- Contact your insurance company
- if your keys have been taken change your locks; (check if your insurance will cover this cost)
- If your cards have been stolen, call your bank or credit Card Company as soon as possible, (the number will be on your statement.)

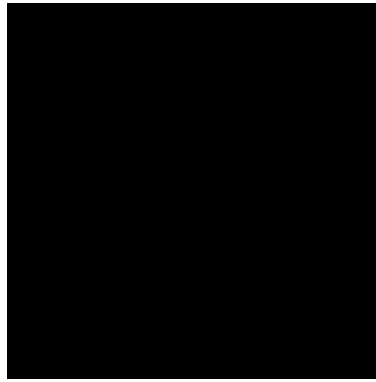
